

OPPORTUNITY POST-DOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

Benefits

- Access to office space, CDRI's library resources, resource for supporting field research (for example, transportation) and can take part in CDRI-organized events (workshops and conferences)
- Work with CDRI researchers on research projects currently implemented by CDRI for 60% of their time \ and can spend 40% of their time on their own research and publications, subject to ethical approval by CDRI's Ethics Review Committee.
- Full-time residency in Phnom Penh is required. CDRI can provide assistance in finding suitable accommodation.
- CDRI will cover basic living costs for the successful applicants during the appointment period.

Essential qualifications and requirements

- A PhD degree in a relevant field.
- Expertise in qualitative and/or quantitative methodologies.
- Strong analytical and communication skills and commitment to professional development of young researchers educated to Masters level.
- Good understanding of socioeconomic and/or political development issues in one or more developing countries.
- Evidence of ability to publish in peer-reviewed journals.
- Experience of grant-writing.
- Knowledge of statistics, familiarity with STATA or other data management and analytical packages (desirable, but not essential).

Roles and responsibilities

- **Research:** the successful applicants will participate in the design and implementation of research projects/programs (methodology and conceptualisation, fieldwork management, data analysis, write reports, publications, and dissemination activities).
- **Grant applications:** the successful applicant will support the identification of new opportunities and in the development of research proposals for submission to granting agencies.
- **Professional development:** the successful applicant will be expected to implement a series of training programs in specific literatures and methods relevant to their expertise.
