



CESCam 2019 Writers Workshop, December 7, 2019 Siem Reap, Cambodia

Comparative Education Society of Cambodia (CESCam) Writers Workshop hosted by the Cambodia Development Resource Institute (CDRI) will be held in conjunction with **the First Biennial Conference of the *Comparative Education Society of Cambodia (CESCam)*** (6-7-December, 2019).

The Programme

The CESCam Writers Workshop offers a unique opportunity to receive individualized support in writing for a peer-reviewed journal. It is run by CESCam committees in collaboration with Dr. Un Kheang, an associate professor of Political Science in Northern Illinois University. Dr Un Kheang will be the main facilitator, in partnership with a senior researcher from Education Unit of CDRI.

Participants

This Workshop will bring together 10-15 participants from Cambodia, on a funded or self-funded basis. **Participants are also encouraged to attend the CEScam conference.** They may be young academicians as well as established researchers and practitioners working in the field of education and development, with rich field experience but perhaps lacking an opportunity to translate their work into academic writing. While the selection process is merit-based, an attempt will be made to maintain geographic and gender balance.

Selection Process and Criteria

The main criterion for selecting workshop participants is that a candidate should have already conducted research. They **should have either a draft paper, a report or a dissertation that they intend to turn into an article.** Researchers working in **all education-related fields** are encouraged to apply. Preference will be given to those applicants who have not had much opportunity to publish in English language journals.



How to apply

Interested participants should complete application form for the Writer's Workshop and attach a 300-word abstract of the paper (or report or dissertation) you hope to adapt for publication (*this can be the same as your abstract for the CESCam conference, if you are planning to present a paper*) through this link (<https://forms.gle/jqFHMT8kjeHd6uhX8>) **by 11 November 2019.**

Please note: Shortlisted applicants may be asked to provide further information or material before their participation is confirmed (e.g. a draft of the paper/report/dissertation that they plan to publish).

Selected participants will be notified **by 18 November 2019.**
