### **Recruitment of Field Survey Enumerators/interviewers**

Cambodia Development Research Institute (CDRI) - Cambodia's leading research institute in Cambodia and Ministry of Rural Development (MRD) are running a three-year collaborative research project (2018–21) called **'Impact of Climate Change Programs in Cambodia: Vulnerability, Poverty and Gender'**. The project receives financial support from UNDP, Bangkok Regional Hub. The main objective is to assess the effectiveness of climate change programs in poverty reduction and addressing vulnerable groups and gender issues. The results will contribute to improving project design, budget formulation and investment, and monitoring and evaluation of MRD.

Environment unit is now **recruiting 8 enumerators/interviewers** who are university students in environment/natural resource and other social fields for our initial field work data collection in Kampong Svay District (Kampong Thom Province) and Koh Soutin District (Kampong Cham province). The schedule of the data collection will be in May 2019. **The tentative date for data collection is from 12<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> May 2019.** The benefits for this field work are as the following:

1. The qualified candidate will get real experiences in conducting research especially interviewing households, conducting key informant interview (KII), and focus group discussion (FGD)
2. Get training on questionnaire, key informant interview (KII), and focus group discussion (FGD)
3. Get training and experience in data cleaning, data entry, and analysis
4. Improve their English writing skills of FGD, KII, and field note reports
5. Get per diem of USD 30 per working day (travel expense will be covered by CDRI)
6. Potential to be selected as CDRI's staff when needed

### **Qualification**

1. Being a University student in the field of environment/natural resource, agriculture or other social fields
2. Being Good in English (reading, speaking, writing, and listening)
3. Willing to learn and travel to the province
4. Willing to conduct interviews face-to-face with the villagers
5. Having honesty, responsibility, self-discipline, and good team-work
6. Being available in May 2019
